ORDER:

The Commissioner of Indian Medicine and Homoeopathy, Chennai in the references first read above has sent a proposal for the formation of "Tamil Nadu Medicinal Plants Board" for the overall development of Medicinal Plants Sector.

2. Meanwhile, the Govt. of India, Ministry of Health and Family Welfare have also requested all the State Governments (including Tamil Nadu) to initiate action to set up a Board or a high powered Committee on the pattern of Medicinal Plants Board set up at the Central level. The Government of India have also intimated about the constitution of the "Medicinal Plants Board" under the Chairmanship of Union Minister of Health and Family Welfare. The Chief Secretary or nominee, Government of Tamil Nadu has been nominated among others as Member (Ex.Officio) for a period of two years in the "Medicinal Plants Board" constituted by the Government of India.

3. The Commissioner of Indian Medicine and Homoeopathy, Chennai has therefore stated that to begin with the Directorate of Indian Medicine and Homoeopathy will function as the Secretariat of Tamil Nadu Medicinal Plants Board. The Director/ Commissioner has to play critical and nodal role in development of Medicinal Plants Board. The bulk of the consumer of such plants and the other important stakeholders would also be in one way or other, related to the Commissionerate. The Secretariat of the Tamil Nadu Medicinal Plants Board will be located in

the Directorate, Indian Medicine and Homoeopathy, and that it is the nodal department for the activities related with the Medicinal plants. The Commissioner of Indian Medicine and Homoeopathy will be the Member Secretary.

4. The Commissioner of Indian Medicine and Homoeopathy has, therefore, proposed to set up Secretariat of Tamil Nadu Medicinal Plants Board under the Chairmanship of Hon'ble Minister for Health with the following members:-

5. The Commissioner of Indian Medicine and Homoeopathy has stated that the Board will meet once in three months. It will also render advise on various steps to be taken to ensure scientific systematic and accelerated development of Medicinal Plants and their sustainable utilization. It will suggest means to explore markets including international markets for such products and will advise the Government on securing patents. The situation can be reviewed after seeing functioning of the Board as well as functioning of Medicinal Plants Board constituted by the Government of India.

6. The Commissioner of Indian Medicine and Homoeopathy has stated that there is no administrative expenditure involved in the proposal and the Board will not require new staff to be created. He has also stated that the existing staff of the Commissionerate of Indian Medicine and Homoeopathy will provide the Secretarial support to the Board. The forming of the Board will not require any extra expenditure to the State Government.

7. The Government after careful examination accept the proposal of the Commissioner of Indian Medicine and Homoeopathy, Chennai and accordingly issue the following orders:

- (i) formation of "Tamil Nadu Medicinal Plants Board" for the overall development of Medicinal Plants Sector and

- (ii) the Directorate of Indian Medicine and Homoeopathy will function as Secretariat of Tamil Nadu Medicinal Plants Board with the following Members under the Chairmanship of Hon'ble Minister for Health and Family Welfare:-

8. The Government also order to include the following objectives of the Medicinal Plants Board:-

- a) To bring about sustainable and equitable development of Medicinal Plants with focus on cost effective cultivation methods, conservation and processing of Medicinal Plants and their products.
- b) To carry out Research and Development in identifying new varieties of Medicinal Plants.
- c) Exploring the market potentiality of end products of Medicinal Plants both within the country and abroad.
- d) To explore the possibility of securing Patent rights for therapeutic value of Medicinal Plants.

9. To achieve the above objectives, the Medicinal Plants Board will carry out the following functions:-

- 1) To encourage and assist in the establishment of demonstration Gardens for Medicinal Plants in Government/Private teaching institutions and Pharmacies.
- 2) To Co-ordinate with Agricultural Universities and other Research Organizations for drawing up of a collaborative programmer to encourage cultivation of Medicinal Plants particularly Plants which are in short supply.

- 3) To access Annual Consumption of Plants based on raw drugs in the State, to pl. developmental programme for Medicinal Plants.
 - 4) To formulate schemes for short term training programme for Farmers C operative Societies and Tribal Population on Agro Techniques, collectio harvesting and storage of Medicinal Plants.
 - 5) To encourage cultivation of Medicinal Plants by Farmers and help them marketing their products by creating linkage between Farmers and Industries.
 - 6) And such of those functions which the Medicinal Plants Board consider essential for development of Medicinal Plants in the State.
 - 7) The expenditure for the formation of the Medicinal Plants Board and oth incidental expenditure should be borne by TAMPCOL, Chennai.
10. The Government also direct that the names of persons and representatives of th institutions and Non Governmental Organisation's will be decided later after the formation of th Board.



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As you may be aware, the Government of India has set up National Medicinal Plants Board (NMPB) with a view to coordinating all matters relating to the medicinal plant sector in the country. During the 10th Plan, the Board has provided financial support for *insitu/ exsitu* conservation over about 30,000 hectares and cultivation over about 40,000 hectares besides supporting R & D and other promotional activities through various R & D Institutes, Universities and NGO's at a total outlay of Rs. 142 crores.

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During 11th Plan, the Board has proposed a 5 to 6 fold increase in the outlays under its scheme. This will require creating capacities at the state level to formulate technically and financially sound proposals for various activities relating to conservation, creation of herbal gardens, area expansion of rare endangered and threatened species, survey, inventorisation and documentation, setting up medicinal plants conservation area/ gene banks, training of collectors, growers and field staff, providing post harvesting infrastructure for medicinal plants etc. Accordingly, the NMPB has requested all the State Medicinal Plant Boards (SMPB) to submit projects for financial assistance under the existing scheme. However, there has been a poor response.

As you would agree that medicinal plants offer opportunities for income generation, alternative crop option and providing health care to the people. To tap this potential, the State Governments can make use of the available financial resources under the schemes of the NMPB. One of the major constraint in proper planning implementation and monitoring at the State level, however, is the absence of a proper organizational structure for the Medicinal Plant Board. The SMPB in its Board meeting held on 10th August, 2007 under the Chairmanship of the Union Minister of Health & Family Welfare had resolved that the State Governments be asked to register the State Medicinal Plant Boards as Societies under the Societies Registration Act. The Medicinal Plant Board could be located in the Health/ AYUSH Department and headed by an officer drawn from the forests/ horticulture/ agriculture department on deputation. It was also resolved that future assistance to States be linked to State Governments setting up a full fledged SMPB with full time CEO and other functionaries. This will ensure better coordination at the district level and below and a more effective implementation and monitoring of conservation and cultivation programmes.

I shall be grateful, if the matter is accorded your personal attention and the activities of the Medicinal Plant Board at the State level could be reviewed by you sometime, so that, the potential which exists in the State is fully utilized. I would also request you to advise the concerned Principal Secretary/ Secretary to ensure submission of project proposals for financial assistance to NMPB as early as possible.

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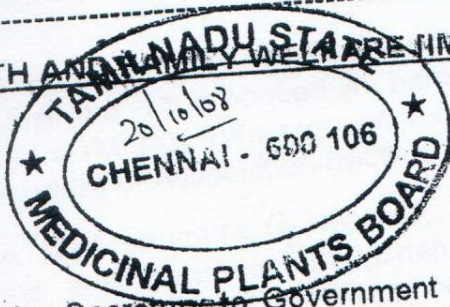

ORDER:

The Secretary to Government of India, Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, New Delhi in the letter first read above, has informed that the National Medicinal Plants Board in its Board meeting held on 10th August, 2007 under the Chairmanship of the Union Minister of Health and Family Welfare resolved that the State Governments should register the State Medicinal Plant Boards as Societies under the Societies Registration Act and that the Medicinal Plants Board could be located in the Health / AYUSH Department and headed by an officer drawn from the Forests / Horticulture / Agriculture Department on deputation basis.

2. The Special Commissioner of Indian Medicine and Homoeopathy, Chennai has furnished the Draft By Laws for the registration of State Medicinal Plants Board, Tamil Nadu under the Tamil Nadu Societies Registration Act 27 of 1975 for the approval of the Government and requested to create one post of Project Director in the cadre of Joint Director carrying the scale of pay of Rs.12,000 - 16500 together with attendant staff which could be filled by one Officer from the Forests / Horticulture / Agriculture Department on deputation basis.

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3. The Government after careful examination accept the proposal of the Special Commissioner of Indian Medicine and Homoeopathy, Chennai and permit him to register the Tamil Nadu State Medicinal Plants Board as a registered society under the Societies Registration Act 27 of 1975 subject to the following changes in the Memorandum of Association.

- (i) The Governing Body of the Society to be modified so as to include only 2 representatives each from industrial establishment, farmers, NGO's and traders instead of 3 as suggested in the Memorandum of Association (MOA).
- (ii) Further, the list of Government members listed out is only 9 in numbers, as against the 11 proposed in para 5 (i) of the Memorandum of Association (MOA). Two more members to be added now itself in the Memorandum of Association (MOA).
- (iii) Till the staff structure is decided, the Special Commissioner Indian Medicine and Homoeopathy, Chennai shall carry out the executive functions, since he has been designated as Secretary (Member Secretary - cum - Chief Executive Officer) of the Society.

4. This orders issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U. O. No. 412 SS (PK) / Health 1/ 2008, dated: 03.10.2008.



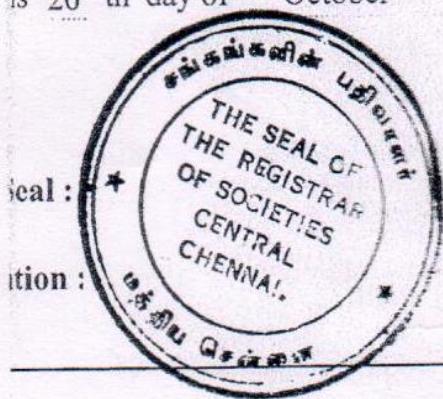

**Memorandum of Association of
STATE MEDICINAL PLANTS BOARD, TAMILNADU**

1. Name of the Society :

The name of the Society shall be "STATE MEDICINAL PLANTS BOARD, TAMIL NADU", hereinafter called as **Board**.

The Registered Office of the Board shall be at Chennai and function at Aringar Anna Government Hospital of Indian Medicine Campus, Arumbakkam, Chennai-106.

2. Aims & Objectives :

(A) The Board shall have the following Aims and Objectives:-

- i. / Promotion of ex-situ and in-situ cultivation and conservation of medicinal plants in Tamil Nadu.
- ii. Identification, Investigation and quantification of medicinal plants.
- iii. / Creation and development of experimental plots of medicinal plants and imparting training to farmers/growers for promotion of ex-situ cultivation.
- iv. / Educating researchers, farmers, students and common man about the uses, benefits and importance of medicinal plants in their day-to-day life.
- v. Conducting training, workshops, seminars etc. on medicinal plants and developing training modules for growers, buyers, NGOs, Traders etc.
- vi. Establishing analytical laboratory for quality testing and certification of medicinal plants produce.
- vii. Ensuring quality control of medicinal plants and medicinal plants produce.
- viii. Providing quality planting stock for ex-situ conservation.
- ix. / Facilitating research in the field of Indian System of Medicine & Homoeopathy and on medicinal plants.
- x . Assessment of demand and supply position relating to medicinal plants both within and outside Tamil Nadu and providing it to growers & buyers.
- xi. / Provide guidance in the formulation of proposals, schemes and programmes to be taken by individuals/ Agencies having access to land for cultivation and infrastructure for collection, storage and transportation of medicinal plants.
- xii. Promotion of co-operative effort among collectors and growers and assisting them to store, transport and market their produce effectively.
- xiii. / Establishing backward and forward linkages between collectors, growers, retailers and wholesalers to ensure proper & effective marketing of medicinal

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plants produces.

- xiv. Setting up of database system for inventorisation, dissemination of information and facilitating the prevention of plants being obtained for medicinal use of plants, which is in the public domain.
- xv. ✓ Matter relating to import/export of raw material, as well as value added products either as medicine, food supplements or as herbal cosmetics including adoption of better techniques for marketing of products to increase their reputation for quality and reliability in the country and abroad.
- xvi. Development of protocols for cultivation and quality control and Encouraging the protection of patent rights and IPR.
- xvii. Monitoring and evaluation of Projects on the promotion and Cultivation of Medicinal Plants.
- xviii. ✓ Registration of farmers, growers, GOs, NGOs, Traders, collectors etc. who are engaged in the medicinal plant sector.

(B) Other objects of the Board shall be :

- i. To create and maintain a fund to which shall be credited:
 - a. All money provided by the Central Government and the Government of Tamil Nadu.
 - b. All fees and other charges received by the Board.
 - c. All money received and accepted by the Board by way of grants, gifts, donations, bequest, subscriptions by way of rent or transfers,
 - d. All money received by the Board in any other manner or from any other sources.
- ii. To acquire, hold and dispose of any property in any manner, consequent upon obtaining approval from the Government of Tamil Nadu in the case of acquisition or disposal of immovable property.
- iii. ✓ To deal with any property belonging to or vested in the Board in such a manner as the Board may deem fit for advancing the functions and main objects of the Board.
- iv. To borrow and raise money with or without security or hypothecation or pledge of whole or any of the immovable properties belonging to the Society or in any other manner whatsoever.
- v. ✓ To construct or otherwise acquire, layout repair, extend, alter, enlarge, improve and use any land for promotion of medicinal plants and for conservation of flora and other immovable property belonging to or held by

- the Board.
- vi. To deposit all money credited to the fund created and maintained under sub clause (1) in a nationalized Bank or to invest it in any manner as the Board may decide and to open bank account current or overdraft and operate the same.
 - vii. To draw, make, accept, endorse and discount cheques, notes, or other negotiable instruments and for these purposes to sign, execute and deliver such assurances and deeds as may be necessary for the purposes of Board.
 - viii. To pay out of the funds belonging to the Board or out of any particular part of such funds the expenses incurred by the Board from time to time including all expenses incidental to the formation of the Board and management and administration of any of the foregoing objects including all rents, rates, taxes outgoing and the salaries of the employees.
 - ix. To do all such lawful acts, deeds, or things as may be necessary incidental or conducive to the attainment of all or any of the objects of the Board.

1. Name of the Society :

4. Jurisdiction:

- x. Setting up of database system for inventorisation, dissemination of information and facilitating the prevention of plants being obtained for medicinal use of plants, which is in the public domain.
- xi. Matter relating to import/export of raw material, as well as value added products either as medicine, food supplements or as herbal cosmetics including adoption of better techniques for marketing of products to increase their reputation for quality and reliability in the country and abroad.
- xii. Development of protocols for cultivation and quality control and Encouraging the protection of patent rights and IPR.
- xiii. Monitoring and evaluation of Projects on the promotion and Cultivation of Medicinal Plants.
- xiv. Registration of farmers, growers, GOs, NGOs, Traders, collectors etc. who are engaged in the medicinal plants sector and issue of Registration Certificates to them..

8. i. President

The Secretary to Government, Health & Family Welfare Department, Govt.of Tamil Nadu shall be the President of the Board and shall preside over the meetings of the Body.

ii. Vice-President

The Director of Horticulture Department shall be the Vice – President of the Board.

iii. Secretary (Member Secretary-cum-Chief Executive Officer)

The Principal Secretary and Director of Indian Medicine & Homoeopathy, Chennai 106, shall be the Secretary (Member Secretary -cum- Chief Executive officer of the Board.

iv. Treasurer

The Managing Director of TAMPCOL shall be the Treasurer of the Board.

9. Enrolment of Members

The following shall be the Members of the Board:

- a. Collectors of Medicinal plants and raw Drugs.
- b. Farmers/ Growers of Medicinal Plants.
- c. Govt. Organizations/ NGOs
- d. Traders/ Marketers/ Exporters

The above category of persons can enroll themselves as members of the Board by registering their names with the Board on payment of fees as detailed below:

10. Management of the Board :

There shall be two committees to manage the Board viz., (i) The Governing Body and (ii) The Executive committee.

(i) The Governing Body:

There shall be **Nineteen** members in the Governing Body, out of which:

- i. **Eleven** members shall be nominated by the Govt. of Tamil Nadu, by a Govt. order.
- ii. **Two** representatives shall be elected from among the Industrial/ Commercial Establishments dealing with manufacture of Indian Medicines.
- iii. **Two** members shall be elected from among the registered* Farmers/ Growers of Medicinal plants.
- iv. **Two** members shall be elected from among the registered * NGOs related to Medicinal Plants Sector in Tamil Nadu.
- v. **Two** representatives shall be elected from among the registered* Traders/ Exporters of ISM.
 - *Registered* means registered with SMPB.

ii. **Term of Office of the General Body/ Executive Committee :**

The tenure of office of the members of the Governing Body is Three years from the date of their nomination/election.

If a vacancy in the office of the Member of the Body, or Committee has occurred the continuing members shall act as if no vacancy had occurred and no act or proceedings of the Body shall be deemed invalid merely by reason of a vacancy in the body or of a defect the appointment of a person acting as a member.

10. Annual Meeting of the Governing Body

- a. The meeting of the Governing Body shall be convened by the Member Secretary of the Board on the directions of the President as often as necessary, but at least once a year by giving a notice of at least ^{21 (Twenty one)} ~~15~~ days to the members. In special circumstances, a meeting of the Governing Body may be called by the President of the Governing Body with a notice of at least five days.

The notice shall specify the day, hour and place and the object of the meeting and, in case any amendment of a bye-law or objects of association as contained in the memorandum is intended to be proposed, shall contain a copy of every such amendment.

Extra ordinary General Meeting :

In special circumstances an extra ordinary meeting for the Governing Body will be called for by the President with the notice of at least ^{21 (Twenty one)} ~~three~~ days.

b

c. **Meeting of the Executive Committee:**

The Executive Committee shall meet once in three months.

d. **Extra-ordinary Meeting of the Executive Committee:**

In special circumstances an extra ordinary meeting of the Executive Committee will be called for by the President with the notice of at least three days.

11. Quorum

- i. The quorum for the meeting of the Governing Body /Executive Committee shall be of at least seven /three members respectively. If the meeting cannot be held for want of quorum, it shall be adjourned and such adjourned meetings shall be held in the next week on the same day, venue and time. At such meeting, no quorum shall be necessary and the members present, whatever be the number shall form the quorum and shall have the same authority as a decision taken in a full Governing Body/Executive Committee meeting.
- ii. Every meeting of the Governing Body/Executive Committee will be presided over by the President. In the absence of the President, the meeting will be presided over by the Vice –President / Secretary.

iii. **Voting Powers**

Each member of the Body shall have one vote. Where there is no unanimity, decisions shall be taken by a majority of vote of the members present and voting. The President shall have a casting vote whenever there is a tie. However, the President of the Governing Body for the reasons to be recorded in writing, may reserve any issue for a decision by the Government of Tamil Nadu.

- iv. All business discussed or decided at the meetings of the Governing Body shall be recorded in a proceedings book which shall be signed by the President of the meeting.

12. Powers and Functions of the Governing Body

- i. The following shall be the functions of the Governing Body:-
- a The Body shall be the apex body for the overall administration and management of the Board.
- b The Body shall periodically review subject to a minimum of twice a year, the



- performance of the Board and suggest appropriate measures to enhance the performance as it deems fit.
- c The Body shall examine the budget prepared by the Board and by various Sub Committees set up by it and accord approval for the same after incorporating amendments as it may deem fit.
- d The Body shall lay down rules regulating recruitment, disciplinary matters, promotion and delegation of powers for appointment to various posts, conditions of services of staff subject to approval of Tamil Nadu Government wherever necessary.
- e The body shall hold meetings, seminars, conferences and to publish books & periodicals as may be decided by the Executive Committee from time to time to fulfill the objectives of the Board.
- f The Body may constitute Sub Committee to perform any specialized and specific functions and such Sub Committees shall exercise such powers as may be delegated by the Body.
- ii. **Subject to the provisions of the Memorandum of Association, the Governing Body shall have the powers to:-**
- a Acquire or take on lease or exchange or purchase or hold otherwise dispose of immovable property for the purpose of the Board with prior approval of the Government of Tamil Nadu.
- b Acquire or sell or exchange or otherwise dispose of movable property for the purpose of the Board as per procedures laid down by the Govt. of Tamil Nadu.
- c Approve the budget estimates and adopt audited annual accounts which shall be presented to it by the Secretary at one of its meetings with such modifications as it may deem necessary.
- d Frames vary or repeal, from time to time, rules, regulations and procedures for the efficient management and administration of the affairs of the Board and relating to its employees.
- e Delegate or withdraw such powers as may be considered necessary to the President, Vice-President, Secretary & Registrar in the interest of the Board.
- f Delegate or withdraw such powers as may be considered necessary to the Executive Committee for the proper conduct of the affairs of its branches and centres, notwithstanding anything to the contrary herein contained in the



- interest of the Board.
- g. Appoint either on a salary or on remuneration such person or persons except President and Secretary as may be necessary for the efficient management and administration of the affairs of the Board and to suspend or take such disciplinary action including dismissal against any such person or persons as it thinks fit.
 - h. Determine charges for all services provided by the Board and recover the same from the users.
 - i. Make and give receipts, release and other discharge for money payable to or by the Board as the case may be and for the claims and demands of the Board.
 - j. Invest and deal with any of the funds and finances of the Board upon such security, investments and in such manner as it thinks fit in the best interest of the Board and from time to time, vary, convert and release such securities and investments.
 - k. Institute, prosecute, conduct, defend, withdraw or abandon any legal or arbitration proceedings by or against the Board and also to compound, allow time for payment for satisfaction of any debts, dues and any claims or demands by or against the Board.
 - l. Pay for any property or rights acquired by or services rendered to the Board including premium payable in respect of any leases taken by the Board.
 - m. Adopt such other means as thinks advisable for carrying out the objectives of the Board.
 - n. All the powers, not specifically, delegated shall vest in the Governing Body.

11. Powers and functions of the Executive Committee

- i. The Committee shall exercise all powers and functions that are delegated to it by the Governing Body from time to time. In particular, the Committee shall have the following powers and duties.
 - a. to observe in all their transactions, under the Act, notified rules and the bye-laws;
 - b. to maintain true and accurate accounts of all money received and expenditure incurred;
 - c. to keep a true account of the assets and liabilities of the Board;
 - d. to prepare and lay before the annual general meeting an income and expenditure account and audited balance sheet ;
 - e. to examine the account, sanction contingent expenditure and supervise, manage and administer all its branches and centres;
 - f. to appoint, suspend, dismiss or punish employees from time to time and to take proper securities from them;

- g. through any member, or officer or employee of the Society or any other persons specially authorized to institute, conduct, defend, compromise, refer to arbitration or abandon legal proceedings by or against the Society or committee or officers to employees concerning the affairs of the Board.
- h. to frame subsidiary rules for the conduct of the business of the Board consistent with these bye-laws;
- i. Generally to carry on the business of the Board.

12. Powers and functions of the Office bearers:

ix) President :

The President shall be the Chair-person of the Society. He is also a responsible person in the activities of the all society affairs.

He shall preside over all the meetings of the General Body and the Executive Committee of the Society.

Direct the members of the society and he can carry out them with the consent of the Secretary.

Give his consultation to the Secretary to conduct ordinary or special meetings of the general body or the Executive Committee of the Society.

Guide and control the full-time salaried persons along with the Secretary & Registrar.

ix) Special Powers of the President

The President of the Governing Body may, in emergent cases or under special circumstances exercise the powers of the Body, in consultation with one or more members of the Governing Body. In case of matters involving finances and all other such cases shall be reported by the President to the Governing Body in its next meeting.

c) Vice-President:

The Vice-President shall attend all the functions of the President in his absence.

d) Secretary :

The Secretary shall be the over-all charge of the society and day-to-day affairs of the office of the State Medicinal Plants Board, Tamil Nadu. The powers vested in him shall be :

- i. In charge of all records of the Society.
- ii. To receive payments and make disbursements.

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- iii. To convene the meetings of the Executive Committee or General Body.
- iv. To keep correct minutes of the proceedings of the meetings of the Executive Committee and the General Body.
- v. To keep an accurate and up-to-date register of the members of the Society.
- vi. To implement the decisions of the General Body and the Executive Committee.
- vii. To appoint full-time salaried persons like Registrar for the day-to-day affairs of the society and it will be noticed to the executive committee for the consent such the persons will be guided and controlled by the Secretary and the President.
- ix. The Secretary shall be the person authorized to sue and sued on behalf of the Board.

d) Treasurer :

- i. The Treasurer shall keep correct accounts of the receipts and payments of the

The Treasurer and Secretary shall jointly operate the Bank accounts of the State Medicinal Plants Board, Tamil Nadu as authorized by the General Body and the Executive Committee.

He shall prepare the budget estimates in consultation with the Secretary at his office and generally exercises general supervision over the keeping of the accounts.

He will closely co-operate with the Secretary in all financial matters. Convene the meetings of the Executive Committee or General Body.

13. Officers & other servants of the Board

i. Chief Executive Officer (Member Secretary):

The Chief Executive Officer shall be the Chief functionary of the Board.

The Secretary (Member Secretary) of the Board shall act also as the Chief

Executive Officer who is the Principal Secretary & Director of Indian Medicine & Homoeopathy, Chennai-106, till such time Chief Executive Officer is appointed..

ii. Deputy Chief Executive Officer :

This post shall be appointed by an officer in the cadre of **Joint Director** on deputation from the Agriculture/ Horticulture/ Forest Department who will be in charge of all technical matters relating to the development of Medicinal Plants Sector in Tamil Nadu. He shall act under the Secretary of the Board and coordinate with the Registrar in Scrutinizing and forwarding the Project proposals to NMPB and in monitoring the Sanctioned NMPB Projects.

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iii. Registrar :

1. a. The Registrar shall be appointed by the Board who need not be a member of the Board and shall take charge of General control of the administration of the Board, and shall be the Administrative Officer of the Board; and he will assist the Secretary (Member Secretary-cum-Chief Executive Officer) in all official business of the Board.
 - b. The Registrar shall be appointed by the Board through Advertisement in the Newspapers. The incumbent of the post shall be not below the rank of a B Grade officer with administrative experience of minimum 10 years in the related field. Retired officers may also be considered for the post on consolidated salary up to the age of 62 years.
 - c. The Board may, at any time, remove the Registrar from office by a resolution passed at a special meeting convened for the purpose and by a majority of not less than two-thirds of the members present and voting; Provided that before taking any action under this clause to remove the Registrar, he shall be given an opportunity of making his representation.
 - d. The appointment of Registrar under clause (a) or his removal from office under clause (b) shall be subject to the approval of the Government and shall not take effect until such approval has been given.
 - e. The Registrar shall with prior permission of the Secretary, convene all the meetings of the Board. The agenda for the meetings shall be prepared by the Registrar and that shall include all matters sent by any member to Executive Committee for favour of consideration in the meeting.
2. When any temporary vacancy occurs in the office of the Registrar or if the Registrar is, by reason of absence, illness or for any other reason, unable to exercise the powers and perform the duties of his office, his powers and duties shall be exercised and performed by such person and in such manner and for such period, not exceeding three months, as the President may direct.
 3. The Board may also recruit such other officers and staff as it may deem necessary for the performance of its functions through employment office.
 4. The remuneration and other conditions of service of the Registrar and other officers and staff of the Board shall be such as may be decided by the Board.
 5. All officers and staff of the Board including Registrar appointed under this Section shall be deemed to be public servants within the meaning of section 21 of the Indian Penal Code.

15. Registration of Farmers (Growers), Traders, NGOs, GOs etc.

Every farmer (grower), raw drug collector, Traders ,NGOs, GOs engaged in the medicinal plants shall be registered with the State Medicinal Plants Board in order to avail the Government subsidy, financial assistance etc.

The Registration fees shall be collected from the farmers (Growers), Traders, NGOs, GOs, Collectors of medicinal plants etc as mentioned below:

Those who have registered under this category shall be issued Registration Certificates with a validity of three years. They will be eligible for applying for the National Medicinal Plants Board grant etc. and eligible to stand & voting power to elect the members to the Board as and when warrants.

16. Accounts & Audit:

- i. The funds of the Board will be maintained in a bank account in any of the nationalized banks to be operated jointly by the Secretary and the Treasurer of the Board.
- ii. The financial year of the Board will have the period of twelve months ending with the 31st day of March each year. The accounts of the Board shall be audited annually by an auditor who qualified as Chartered Accountant or by the

Examinee of Local Fund Audit as decided by the Committee.

- iii. The services of the members of the Standing Executive Committee shall be honorary but they may be paid traveling and daily allowances on a scale fixed by the Board from time to time.
- iv. All the provisions under all the sections of the Societies Registration Act 1975 as applicable to the Government of Tamil Nadu shall apply to the Board.
- v. The books of accounts, book containing the register of members and the Minutes books will be made available at the registered office of the State Medicinal Plants Board, Tamil Nadu, during Business hours for inspection by members free of charge. The Receipts and Expenditure accounts and Balance Sheet will be issued to the Members on application at free of cost.

17. Dissolution :

If upon the winding up or dissolution of the Board there remains after satisfaction of all its debits and liabilities or any property whatsoever the same shall not be paid to or distributed among the members of the Board, but shall be given or transferred to some other institution having similar objects of the Board at or before the time of dissolution, or to the Government of Tamil Nadu.
